Pandemic Disrupts Off-Season Activities

iding at least six feet apart and wear-King a facemask should not be an issue for snowmobilers out on the trails in Iowa this winter. We're used to that. Where the coronavirus pandemic gets in the way is with conducting the business of the sport and disrupting off-season activities.

Before the second to last Sunday of August, the ISSA Board of Directors had not met since the second Sunday of March, citing health and safety concerns for region directors. With fall fast approaching, ISSA President Brian Carmichael finally scheduled a meeting last month to get back to work under this "new normal."

"I need all board members to be present, as we have not had a meeting all summer with COVID-19, and we need to have one," Carmichael urged in an email announcing the date to the board.

Concerns over the coronavirus also impacted the ISSA's Review and Selection Committee (RSC) meeting in Thompson July 27. Only committee members were allowed to attend in person, and those present were expected to comply with social distancing guidelines. Club members were invited to participate remotely via Zoom.

"It has been an interesting few months with some interesting challenges to say the least," began RSC co-administrator and Past ISSA President Chris Willey. "As we get ready for the upcoming 2020-21 snowmobile season, we are keeping everyone's safety in mind. To do so, we had to make a few changes to the meeting format this year."

Virus affects legislation

The pandemic also stalled what little bit of momentum the ISSA's push to merge the registration and trail pass stickers had gained at the Iowa Legislature earlier this year. After three consecutive years of inactivity, the bill—House File 749—finally emerged from a subcommittee in the Senate Ways and Means Committee but failed to reach the floor for a vote.

Call it bad timing. Simultaneously to the bill moving out of subcommittee in early March, the coronavirus had officially arrived in Iowa, and the legislative session was consequently suspended for two months. When the Legislature reconvened in early June, legislators were faced with civil unrest, and priorities had shifted. The session ended June 14 after a marathon weekend.

"Communication with legislators was

difficult with little input from the lobby or constituents," ISSA Lobbyist Mike Heller noted the Monday following adjournment. "The legislature dealt with difficult social issues like abortion, restricting absentee ballots and police techniques in the clos-

"While we were discussed in caucus until the closing hours of the session, our snowmobile single-tag bill died," Heller continued. "Legislators focused on the budget, and unfortunately, our bill was not brought up for a vote. The virus impacted a lot of bills, including ours."

Both Heller and ISSA Legislative Committee Chair Jim Willey thanked snowmobilers for their phone calls to legislators last year and called it a minor victory the bill made it out of subcommittee. When the Iowa Legislature resumes this January, the measure will likely be taken up again.

"As the song goes, maybe next year," Willey said, later thanking Heller for "everything you could do in such a bizarre vear."

National events cancelled

On the national and even international level, the pandemic affected major off-season events. In April, the American Council of Snowmobile Associations' 21st Annual D.C. Fly-In was cancelled "because of our concern with the health and well-being of the snowmobile leadership and the uncertainty of Congress' schedules and availability."

"We have issues that are important, and time will be of the essence once the coronavirus is under control and a new normal settles in," ACSA Executive Director Christine Jourdain wrote in her weekly E-News March 27. "Our plan is to prepare some summaries on the issues. This will help us keep our issues in the forefront of Congress and remind them what is so very important to us as winter recreationists."

In June, the 52nd Annual International Snowmobile Congress scheduled for Regina, Saskatchewan, was also cancelled due to the coronavirus.

"After careful deliberation, and in following the latest guidance from national, provincial, state and local authorities, we are sad to announce that ISC 2020 will not be taking place," organizers posted on social media in April. "As the world is still greatly affected by the spread of CO-VID-19, we can't in good conscience risk the health and well-being of our guests."

In July, another off-season casualty of

"Keeping in mind that attendees historically travel to Hay Days from over 30 states and several Canadian provinces, we must look at the bigger picture with respect to the risks involved," the Sno Barons wrote on the Hay Days website. "It would not be practical to implement a mitigation plan utilizing current guidelines without severely impacting both the vendor and spectator experience."

Closer to home

In Iowa, the pandemic also forced the Iowa Snowdrifters to cancel its annual Big Town Show Down Truck and Tractor Pull in Region 9, the club's primary fundraiser for the year normally held in early August. The club's event committee announced the cancellation on Facebook in July.

"While it was a difficult decision, it is ultimately what is best for the safety of our community, our club members and spectators," the club wrote. "We look forward to hosting an awesome event in 2021!"

In northwest Iowa, the annual Rivers Bend Shootout watercross race at Rock Valley had already been cancelled for the year prior to the pandemic, but Kelly Roder of the Sioux County Snowmobile Club said the club's decision last September "to take a year off seemed to be pretty good timing." Normally held in the middle of the summer, the Region 1 club had hosted the IWA-sanctioned races the last five years.

In August, however, the Lyon County Sno-Lyons, also of Region 1, decided to move forward with a Snowmobile Swap and Show Saturday, Sept. 12, at the Rapid Speedway in Rock Rapids. The event, according to the club's Facebook page, is designed "to help us kick off the start of sledding season." The decision to postpone Hay Days this year seems to be working in the club's favor.

"The club thought it would be a great way to boost morale and hopefully become an annual event," Region 1 Director Jim Skinner explained. "With major events being cancelled this year, most snowmobilers are possibly looking for an event like this to attend. Please let all your clubs and anyone involved in the sport know about this swap meet."

As club meetings resume this fall and as trail work looms on the horizon, the ISSA is encouraging club members to observe social distancing and comply with health and safety guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control.

As announced in this month's Club News, a handful of clubs are already plan-

ning to hold meetings outdoors, and according to the club's Facebook page, the Central Iowa Snowmobilers are planning to host their fall grass drags Oct. 24 at Grundy Center.

Convention still on

As for the ISSA convention this fall, clubs from Region 7 are still planning to host the 47th annual event at the Ouality Inn and Suites Conference Center in Ames Nov. 13-15. Region 7 Director John Kahler is chairing this year's planning committee.

"I don't ever recall—at least during my time with the ISSA anyway—of cancelling the convention for any reason," Kahler said. "We are going to move forward with planning the event this year and will comply with all health and safety precautions."

2020 convention forms appear on pages 7-8 of this month's issue. Interested ISSA members are encouraged to mail in their registrations in a timely manner. Checks will be held until Nov. 1, at which time the ISSA will make its final determination to host convention or not. If the convention is cancelled, all checks will be returned.

As always, booking hotel rooms is the responsibility of the attendee. A block of rooms under the ISSA Convention has been held at the hotel through Oct. 15. Negotiated rates are \$109 per night. While the Big XII conference schedule remains in limbo as of press time, Iowa State football may have a home football game that Saturday so the committee is advising to book rooms early and to verify the hotel's cancellation policy at that time.

The ISSA Awards Committee has also extended its 2020 nomination deadline to Sept. 15. Forms are available online at www.iowasnowmobiler.com/issa/awards. Recipients are slated to be announced at this fall's state convention.

Convention Planned for November in Ames

The ISSA is inching closer to its Golden Anniversary as the General Membership Assembly is slated to meet for the 47th time this fall in Ames.

The 2020 ISSA Annual Convention is scheduled for Nov. 13-15 at the Quality Inn and Suites Conference Center, just west of the middle exit (113) off I-35. Clubs in Region 7 are hosting this

year's event, and ISSA Region 7 Director John Kahler is chairing the Convention Planning Committee.

"Details are still being ironed out, but we are working hard to line up entertainment and seminars for a great weekend," Kahler said.

ISSA President Brian Carmichael will end his two-year term convention weekend, and Vice President Scott Nauman is expected to succeed him. The search is on for the next vice president.

Kahler, a certified instructor, will be coordinating a groomer certification course Saturday afternoon. "It just makes sense to have a class convention weekend," he explained. "We have a captive audience, and it's a good draw to get club members down here."

Bids to host the 2021 ISSA Annual Convention are due to the ISSA Board of Directors by its October meeting. Following a west-to-east rotation, clubs from northwest Iowa will be responsible for hosting next fall's event. Central and eastern clubs swapped spots the last two years.

Winter Cames marks 40th Anniversary

he University of Okoboji Winter Games reached a milestone last January when the annual winter festival in the Iowa Great Lakes region celebrated its 40th Anniversary out on the ice. Making sure the area's snowmobile trails were ready for the special occasion were the dedicated members of the Dickinson County SnowHawks.

Formed in the 1970s, the Region 1 club has participated in the four-day event pretty much since its inception in 1981. Over the years, snowmobile events held in conjunction with the Winter Games have included fun runs, radar runs and 120 youth demo rides. Most importantly, though, the club's primary role is to get the trails in shape for the weekend's anticipated heavy traffic.

During the weeks and days leading up to the last weekend in January, trail reports and snowfall totals are regularly posted on the club's Facebook page. Club members also issue advisories on lake conditions and potentially hazardous areas to avoid. They want to make sure everyone has a good time during their visit to the area.

"Our number one priority is making sure our trails are groomed and making sure everyone knows where to go or not go on the lakes," explained SnowHawks president Kevin Winters. "We really can't stake the lake, but we try to put out information on our trail maps on how to get on and off and where the main routes are to use on the lake. We also try to warn everybody of the bad spots as well."

A club member since 2001, Winters is one of several operators who volunteers his time to run the club's 2010 Prinoth groomer. Not counting lake travel, the club marks and maintains more than 100 miles of trail. Most of it is in the ditches, but they do make it

onto a few area rail-trails, including the multi-purpose Iowa Great Lakes Trail. Winters said early participation by the club in the development stages of that trail secured and preserved their longtime access.

Weather permitting






